FOREWORDby Julia Leferman, Secretary General, The Brewers of Europe



Dear Reader,

The European brewing industry is a dynamic reflection of our continent's cultural, economic and social transformations. In the face of challenges that range from a global pandemic to economic turbulence, its importance shines through.

The 2024 edition of the European Beer Trends Report underscores these issues, providing a snapshot of production, consumption and trade patterns alongside brewing's ongoing contributions to society. Also crucially, it offers valuable insights for brewers as they adapt to a landscape that demands innovation, sustainability and strategic agility.

The Covid pandemic may be in our rear-view mirror, but its aftershocks are still being felt by the beer industry, particularly the on-trade sector, which includes bars, restaurants and pubs. Between 2019 and 2020, beer sales in the European Union fell from 320 million hectolitres to 298 million, a decline that mirrored the closure of hospitality venues during peak seasons and a shift towards at-home consumption. Whilst in 2022 we were able to witness a steady, but difficult recovery of over half those volumes, 2023 told a different story (301 million), with many of the gains made in 2022 falling back again, as economic pressures continued to bite and consumer spend decreased.

High inflation, increased production costs, rising prices for raw materials, energy and logistics, coupled with reduced consumer spending power and changing consumer trends, have slowed production and export growth. These factors sit alongside supply chain bottlenecks exacerbated by geopolitical instability, including the war in Ukraine.

Meanwhile, beer production in the European Union reached 346 million hectolitres in 2023, more than 3% down on 2022. This also serves to highlight the challenging times that brewers and the whole beer value chain are living through, with the lingering effects of economic shifts and increased production costs.

These challenges amplify the need for brewers to enhance operational efficiencies and secure sustainable supply chains. Exports (both to third countries and within the EU internal market), which had become a key growth engine for the sector, particularly in markets where domestic beer consumption has declined, have steadily fallen in the last two years.

The hospitality sector, traditionally the lifeblood of the beer industry, continues to face pressures, and it has yet to recover its share. Since 2019, the on/off-trade mix shifted even further towards off-trade consumption – where once on-trade bars, restaurants, cafés and restaurant represented a third of the EU beer market, now it is more like one quarter. Reinvigorating the beer hospitality sector is absolutely crucial as this is where the majority of the value added and jobs are generated by beer.

Europe's breweries have embraced ingenuity and promoting responsible drinking, also through the products themselves. Initiatives to improve efficiency, invest in sustainable practices and diversify offerings have helped to partially mitigate at least some pressures. As brewers step up efforts to support moderate consumption, non-alcoholic beers now account for around one in 15 beers sold on the market — a testament to brewers' ability to cater to evolving consumer preferences through innovation and significant investment.

One of the trends that is still just about bucking the trend is actually the continued proliferation of breweries. An estimated 9,723 breweries were operating in the EU by the end of 2023, up 40 since the previous year, but a far cry from the growth last decade when the EU was seeing a thousand new breweries popping up every year. Even if the numbers of breweries are increasing at not nearly the same annual rate they were, this still signals a continued appetite for innovation and diversity in beer offerings. The growth reflects not only consumer interest in local, specialty and innovative products but also the entrepreneurial spirit of the beer sector, even in the face of significant and growing challenges. From microbreweries to regional players, the diversity of offerings has enriched Europe's beer culture and created opportunities for small businesses to emerge. The fragile situation, with many brewery closures in amongst the brewery openings, shows nevertheless how support is needed.

The brewing industry today faces many external challenges, including the ongoing climate crisis, inflationary pressures and geopolitical tensions. Extreme weather events and disruptions to agricultural supply chains underline the need for sustainable practices and investments. Breweries are already leading the way, reducing environmental footprints and adopting circular economy principles. However, further support from governments and policymakers will be essential to ensure the sector's resilience and sustainability.

Consumer trends, too, despite posing a number of challenges, offer opportunities for innovation, particularly for beer as a lower alcohol beverage. The rise of non-alcohol beer, for instance, caters to certain occasions, times of the day and consumers seeking choice and balance in their life, while not compromising on taste. Specialty beers continue to find their place, reflecting a growing preference for unique and locally inspired products. These trends call for brewers to invest in product development and marketing strategies that resonate with diverse demographics.

Getting to grips with changing consumer behaviours and reduced spending power as many people feel the pinch, will also be critical to ensure Europe has a beer hospitality environment that caters for consumers and brewers' needs. We need this part of the economy booming again, also for the benefit of job creation, tax revenue generation and value added for the wider EU economy.

The political landscape will also shape the future of brewing in Europe, and brewers have a unique opportunity to advocate for supportive policies that recognise their cultural, economic and environmental contributions. We have a new European Commission and Parliament, so the time is now to shift gears.

The European beer industry is more than an economic sector. It is part of the cultural fabric that unites communities and celebrates shared heritage. As brewers continue to innovate and adapt, their ability to meet consumer expectations while navigating external pressures will define the industry's trajectory.

Let us celebrate the innovators, entrepreneurs and enthusiasts who ensure that Europe's beer story continues to evolve while honouring its rich traditions. They exemplify the resilience and creativity that are hallmarks of European brewing. Let us work together to shape a thriving future for beer in Europe.











NUMBER OF ACTIVE BREWING COMPANIES 2023





14 GLOSSARY

BEER PRODUCTION:

Beer produced within a given country.

BEER CONSUMPTION:

Beer consumed within a given country.

BEER CONSUMPTION PER CAPITA:

Consumption per head in a given country.

BREWERY:

A plant or an establishment for beer production.

BREWING COMPANY:

A company which produces and / or sells beer, operating one or more breweries. These companies may also be involved in activities other than brewing beer, such as the production of soft drinks and bottled mineral water.

DIRECT EMPLOYMENT:

Employment directly by the brewing companies.

EXCISE DUTY REVENUE RELATED TO BEER:

Government revenues generated from excise duties on the sale of beer.

EXPORT - EXTRA-EU:

Extra-EU exports of goods are goods which leave the territory of the European Union for a third country after being placed under the customs procedure for exports (for definitive export) or outward processing (goods for working, further processing) or repair or following inward processing.

EXPORT - INTRA-EU:

Intra-EU exports of goods are goods which leave a Member State of the EU for another Member State for definitive export, outward processing or repair or following inward processing.

HECTOLITRE (HL):

A hectolitre is a metric unit of volume or capacity where one hectolitre equals 100 litres.

IMPORT - EXTRA-EU:

Extra-EU imports of goods are goods which enter the territory of the European Union from a third country and are placed under the customs procedure for free circulation within the EU (as a general rule goods intended for consumption), inward processing or processing under customs control (goods for working, processing or repair) immediately or after bonded warehousing.

IMPORT - INTRA-EU:

Intra-EU imports of goods are goods which enter a Member State of the EU from another Member State for definitive import (as a general rule goods intended for consumption), inward processing or processing under customs control (goods for working, processing or repair) immediately or after bonded warehousing.

MICROBREWERY:

A brewery with yearly production up to 1,000 hectolitres.

OFF-TRADE SECTOR:

Beer sales through wholesale and retail (shops, supermarkets and other outlets).

ON-TRADE SECTOR:

Beer sales through (licensed) pubs, clubs, bars, restaurants, etc., also called the hospitality sector.

15 METHODOLOGY

The data for the 2024 edition were mainly collated via the national brewers' associations through surveys by The Brewers of Europe.

With the received data the corresponding tables and charts have been prepared and verified with the interlocutors from different countries. Therefore, unless indicated otherwise in this or previous editions, all data comes from national brewers associations.

When data was not available through national associations other sources were used to complete as much as possible the tables. The sources used for this edition include:

- National brewers' associations data
- Furostat
- European Commission
- National authorities

Figures contained in some tables may have been rounded and also corrected from previous editions of this publication.
